PRIVACY DATA PROTECTION STATEMENT

SATA is dedicated to protecting the confidentiality and privacy of information entrusted to it. As part of this fundamental obligation, SATA is committed to the appropriate protection and use of personal information (sometimes referred to as Personal Data) that we collect about you. Please review this privacy statement (“Privacy Statement”) to learn more about how we collect, use, and share and protect the personal information that we have obtained.

1. Collection and use of personal information

1.1 What information we collect

We obtain your personal information through our Registration Forms for the purpose of reserving your seat in any of the events held by SATA and inviting you to any other future gatherings, if we receive your consent. We collect personal information such as your name, surname, job title, contact details and depending on whether you attend a free or a paid event. We also collect the payment method of your choice as well as bank details for paid events. The personal information provided to us by you, will not be used for any other purpose, other than the purposes mentioned above.

1.2 The legal grounds we have to use your personal information

SATA generally collects only the personal information necessary to fulfill the registration process. Regional SADC Data Protection Guidelines help us to protect the collected information.

2. Sharing and transfer of Personal Data

We do not share personal information with third parties, except as necessary for our legitimate professional and business needs. If the information we hold about you is incorrect, you are entitled to ask us to correct any inaccuracies in the personal information. You have the right to object to us processing your personal information if we are not entitled to use it any more. To the best of our ability, access to your personal information is limited to those who have a need to

know. Those individuals who have access to the data are required to maintain the confidentiality of such information. We also make reasonable efforts to retain personal information only for so long as necessary for business needs. The period for which data is retained will depend on the specific nature and circumstances under which the information was collected.
